Due to the limited number of spaces, participating teams will be selected through a random lottery system

All teams submitting lottery entry forms during the hours of 10am-10am on April 16-17 will be entered into the lottery for a *possible* space in the Festival.

➔ A random database lottery will be used to select the teams for the limited number of spaces.

➔ Teams will be notified of their status via e-mail by Saturday, April 18 (a list will also be posted on the '2015 Girls Youth Lacrosse Festival' website at www.lakeoswegosports.com).

◆ Grades 5/6 & 7/8 Lake Oswego Host Teams receive automatic spots in the Festival

◆ Grades 5/6 Division = a maximum total of **20*** teams

◆ *4 spaces will go to out-of-state teams in a separate lottery taking place on the same day.

◆ Grades 7/8 Division = a maximum total of **18*** teams

◆ *4 spaces will go to out-of-state teams in a separate lottery taking place on the same day.

Team Formation & Player Eligibility Requirements:

Two Divisions: 1) **Grades 5/6** (Oregon U12) and 2) **Grades 7/8**. (Oregon U14)

Open to middle school/junior high girls teams. Open to girls who are currently in **5th- 8th grades** (2014/2015 school year). Please note: The purpose of this festival is to provide a fun, end-of-the-season play day for existing 2015 spring teams. *This festival is not open to all-star/select/ elite and/or traveling teams.*

NOTES:

◆ All players and coaches must be current US Lacrosse Members.

◆ **4th grade teams are not eligible to play in this Festival.** 5th/6th grade teams with 4th graders who played throughout the season on an existing spring 5/6 team are eligible to play in the Festival as long as the team predominately (80% or higher) consists of 5th &/or 6th grade players.

◆ Players in 6th grade who played throughout the season on a team that played in a 7th/8th grade division are eligible to play in the 7/8 division. Players who are in 7th or 8th grade are not eligible to play in the 5/6 division.

◆ Players who are two or more grade levels below the actual division grade level are not eligible.

(i.e. 3rd graders are not eligible to play in the Festival. 5th graders are not eligible to play in the 7/8 grade division)

Grades 5/6 Division (Oregon U12): **\$175 per team** (3 mini-games)

Grades 7/8 Division (Oregon U14): **\$230 per team** (4 mini-games)

- ☑ **By Friday, May 8, 2015: TEAM ROSTER FORM** must be completed and received. ***New online only:** The form can be found on the 2015 Girls Youth Lacrosse Festival Page (*same place as the Lottery Entry Form*).

- ☑ **By Friday, May 22, 2015: PLAYER CONSENT FORM** must be received
 - **Parents must know your team name and coach's name in order to complete the form.** Parents complete the form online at www.lakeoswegosports.com, found under the '2015 Girls Youth Lacrosse Festival' page. The online form will be submitted directly to LO Parks & Recreation.
 - **Team Reps./Coaches** are responsible to check status of Consent Forms received from their respective teams. Roster status can be viewed online at www.lakeoswegosports.com under the '2015 Girls Youth Lacrosse Festival' page. *Coaches, please note: player names will be added to your online roster list only after we have received their Consent Forms. If you do not see a name you believe should be listed, please contact the players and remind them to turn in their form.

Festival Format:

Grades 5/6: Each team will play three (3) mini-games of 30 minutes -Running clock.

Grades 7/8: Each team will play four (4) mini-games of 30 minutes -Running clock.

No scores, no standings. Players will have a chance at winning fun prizes through a drawing.

Rules of Play: US Lacrosse Official Rules for Girls & Women's Lacrosse

- **Grades 5/6 Division:** (USL U-13 rules; **no checking, 4 goal differential in effect**)
- **Grades 7/8 Division:** (USL U-15 rules; **modified checking, 4 goal differential in effect**)

Umpires provided by Oregon Women's Lacrosse Umpires Association – *US Lacrosse members.*

Any special festival rules will be presented to team coaches/managers prior to festival play.

Insurance: Insurance coverage is the responsibility of each team. The City of Lake Oswego does not provide insurance for teams, coaches or individual players.

Festival Locations in Lake Oswego, Oregon:

Festival Headquarters:

◆ **Lakeridge High School: 1235 Overlook Drive – Lake Oswego, OR 97034**

◆ **3-4 Satellite fields (grass & artificial) will be 0.5 – 3.0 miles from Festival Headquarters.**

Note: If there is more than one team from your community, please plan on different coaches for each team. All coaches (& players) must be current US Lacrosse members.

What happens if my team doesn't get a randomly selected space in the lottery?

All teams who entered into the lottery and did not get a space will be placed on a waiting list for the 2015 Festival. The order of the wait list will be based on the order of the team's placement in the initial lottery (in-state team wait list and out-of-state wait list will be separate).

Teams who did not register for the Festival Lottery will be placed on the wait list on a first-come first-served basis, after those teams placed on the wait list from the lottery, regardless if they are in-state or out-of-state.
